



JH Ranch Future Leader Scholarship 2018

JH Ranch is offering three (3) \$1000 scholarships to qualified applicants that are planning to continue their education in a college, university or technical training facility. JH Ranch's summer program encourages its guests to be leaders in their communities, wherever the Lord may place them.

Eligibility – The applicant must:

1. Be a current graduate of Etna High School or Scott River High School
2. Homeschool graduates from the Scott Valley area will be evaluated on a case by case basis. (Confirming residency and completion of California State requirements for High School completion equivalency.)
3. Or be an alumni of Etna High School or Scott River High School
4. Have a current minimum of a 2.5 cumulative grade point average
5. Provide official or unofficial transcript(s) confirming grades
6. Be enrolled in an institution of higher education in the Fall of 2018

Criteria for selection:

1. In-school and outside-of-school participation in leadership and activities.
2. Plans for college and or future career training
3. Completeness of application.

Application process:

1. The complete application shall consist of the following:
 - a. Application form filled out completely and legibly.
 - b. An essay (minimum 600 words) explaining what it means to be a servant leader and how you have served your community during your high school years. Please also include how you intend to serve your community after you finish your college career or future career training. Community would be defined as where you live, where you work, where you volunteer and/or your friends and family. Please be realistic and honest. We believe everyone has leadership potential and opportunities to serve.
 - c. 2 letters of reference from someone supervising or directing you in service or leadership in or out of school. You do not have to be an officer of a club; you could have seen a need and followed through with what was needed to lead by example.
2. The packet must be received by Anne Hilton by April 10th, 2018 3:30 pm or mailed with a postmark no later than by 4/10/18. No late or incomplete applications will be considered.
