Dear Applicant

The Sheriff Lopey Foundation strives to improve the social, educational, and community interests of Siskiyou County residents, especially our youth. One of the Foundation's main objectives is to provide scholarships for qualified individuals who plan to pursue law enforcement careers with federal, state or local agencies.

This scholarship is available to individuals pursuing a career in law enforcement and who are currently enrolled in high school and will graduate from the 12th grade this year, and are continuing their education in the law enforcement profession. The applicant must be a resident of Siskiyou County and provide the information requested on the Sheriff Lopey Foundation website at www.sherifflopey.com.

Applicants will be judged on a composite consideration of their grade point average (GPA) and school transcripts, student extracurricular activities and community service. The purpose of the selection process is to judge the applicant's desire and ability to acquire the vocation of: police officer, deputy sheriff, correctional officer/deputy, highway patrolman, game warden, federal agent, state narcotic agent, etc. and non-peace officer agency classifications such as criminalists, or crime scene investigators will be considered. The decision of the judges is final. The grant will be awarded upon proof of registration to an accredited school, community college, university or other accredited college-level institution. The amount of each grant is \$1,000.00. Three scholarships will be awarded contingent upon eligibility criteria being met.
