For the duration of the Siskiyou Promise program currently offering full enrollment funding and a \$200 book voucher to all new COS enrollees who are 2018 graduates of Siskiyou County high schools, the Scott Valley Bank scholarship will be formatted as follows: The Scott Valley Bank program will fund books in excess of the \$200 Siskiyou Promise allowance for 4 semesters to one full-time student at COS. Following the recipient's successful completion of two years of study at College of the Siskiyous, Scott Valley Bank will award the recipient a stipend in the amount of \$2,500 to apply toward enrollment at a 4-year college or university. The stipend is contingent upon proof of the recipient's enrollment at a 4-year college or university for the next academic term. Book funds will be distributed to the recipient each semester contingent upon compliance with Scholarship Rules.*

SCHOLARSHIP QUALIFICATIONS & APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

- Return this completed application cover sheet along with the following:
 - an official copy of your high school transcript
 - a personal essay (minimum 65 words - maximum 2 pages) describing your interest in business, finance, or financial services. Include a description of how your philosophies have been influenced and developed by your activities, employment (paid or volunteer), and studies. You may also briefly describe extracurricular activities and honors earned.
 - three letters of recommendation or other supporting documents
- A minimum of a B average (3.0 cumulative grade-point average) is required to apply.
- Applicants must reside in and will graduate from high school in the College of the Siskiyous or Shasta College attendance area.

JUDGING AND NOTIFICATION:

All qualifying scholarship applications received by the stated deadline will be evaluated by a review panel selected by Scott Valley Bank. Review and compilation of scores will take place by May 4, 2018. Finalists will be contacted by telephone or email and invited for a personal interview. Other applicants will be thanked for their interest via US Mail.

Recipient will be required to submit a valid tax ID before receiving stipend.

Sorry, applications submitted late or in incomplete format will not be considered. Please email or phone with questions.

SCHOLARSHIP RULES

- Maintain a full college course load in all semesters at College of the Siskiyous
- Maintain a 3.0 or greater Grade Point Average at College of the Siskiyous
- Follow the Business Administration or Finance curriculum advised by College of the Siskiyous
- Send a copy of your grades to Scott Valley Bank each semester - An official transcript must be provided if requested
- Payment of scholarship is by reimbursement or student may arrange direct billing by the college registrar and bookstore
- Certain items may be excluded from scholarship funding such as: "supplies" such as paper, backpack, and art or other elective class supplies.

Scott Valley Bank is pleased to offer a scholarship opportunity to graduating seniors who will attend **College of the Siskiyous** with an interest in **Business, Business Administration, Financial Services or Finance**. *One scholarship is available.* Students from the College of the Siskiyous attendance area who have *demonstrated interest* in business or finance and who have a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA may apply.

In 2017, we formatted the award differently due to tuition needs at College of the Siskiyous being met for all Siskiyou County graduates via the Siskiyou Promise program. For the duration of the Siskiyou Promise program, which currently offers second dollar enrollment funding after state and federal grants and a \$200 book voucher to all new COS enrollees who are 2018 graduates of Siskiyou County high schools, the Scott Valley Bank scholarship will fund books in excess of the \$200 book voucher for 4 semesters for one full-time student at COS. Following the recipient's successful completion of two years of study at COS, Scott Valley Bank will award the recipient a stipend in the amount of \$2,500 to apply toward enrollment at a 4-year college or university. The stipend is contingent upon proof of graduation from College of the Siskiyous in addition to proof of enrollment at a four-year college or university for the next academic term. In the event of a decrease in Siskiyou Promise funding, the stipend may be applied early toward enrollment at College of the Siskiyous.

The recipient must attend College of the Siskiyous as a full-time student and maintain a 3.0 grade point average for 2 years. I have enclosed applications for any senior wishing to apply. The application deadline is Friday, April 27, 2018. No late applications will be considered - however, applications may be faxed up to the deadline and should be followed by mailed originals.
