The Shasta Lily Quilt Guild is again offering a \$1,000 Scholarship to a graduating senior from any Siskiyou County high school that is pursuing a career in the following artistic fields: quilting, fabric design, fabric or fiber arts, graphic design, fine arts or applied arts. Applications from COS students transferring to other schools will also be considered, as well as past Shasta Lily Quilt Guild Scholarship winners.

Applicants must have a completed SHASTA LILY QUILT GUILD SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION, TRANSCRIPTS, REQUIRED ESSAY, TWO LETTERS OF REFERENCE and a PORTFOLIO OF ARTISTIC EXPRESSION. Please refer to the application packet for specific details.

**TRANSCRIPTS**

High school applicants must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 through seven (7) semesters, unweighted. Please submit an official transcript with your application.

**REQUIRED ESSAY:**

In an organized, well written essay of no more than 250 words, describe your interest in your chosen field. Be sure to include your experiences in this field and your future plans, as well as other pertinent coursework and activities. This essay should express your best writing skills.

**TWO LETTERS OF REFERENCE:**

One of your letters of reference must be from a teacher or a school official.

**PORTFOLIO OF ARTISTIC EXPRESSION:**

Such Portfolio may include completed projects, photographs of completed projects, samples of graphic designs or anything deemed appropriate. A digital (thumb drive) portfolio of the applicant's works is optional in lieu of physical projects and will be acceptable. Presentation is important.

Funds will be released to scholarship recipients only upon receipt of proof of enrolment in a college program. Funds must be claimed in the first semester of college attendance.

Completed application packets must be received or postmarked by March 31, 2020. All documentation must accompany the application. **Application packets are to be mailed or delivered to:**
