Graduating seniors from all Siskiyou County high schools who are pursuing careers in the following artistic fields are invited to apply: quilting, fabric design, fabric or fiber arts, graphic design, fine arts or applied arts. Applications from COS students transferring to other schools will also be considered.

High school applicants must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 through seven (7) semesters, unweighted. Please submit an official transcript with your application.

Required essay:

In an organized, well written essay of no more than 250 words, describe your interest in your chosen field. Be sure to include your experiences in this field and your future plans, as well as other pertinent coursework and activities. This essay should express your best writing skills.

Two letters of reference:

One of your letters of reference must be from a teacher or a school official.

Portfolio of Artistic Expression:

Such Portfolio may include completed projects, photographs of completed projects, samples of graphic designs or anything deemed appropriate. Presentation is important.

Funds will be released to scholarship recipients only upon receipt of proof of enrolment in a college program. Funds must be claimed in the first semester of college attendance.

Completed applications must be postmarked by March 30, 2018. All documentation must accompany the application. Applications are to be mailed to Shasta Lily Quilt Guild, c/o Vicki Melo, 211 Kennedy Dr., Mt. Shasta, CA 96067.
